# Guidelines for the presentation of the candidates for the appointment to the Confederal Council and the Supervisory Board for the sexennial 2021-2027

The Confederal Assembly of the Association World Confederation Mornese of Past Pupils of the FMA convened for July 31, 2021, in ordinary session, is called to appoint the members of the Confederal Council and the Supervisory Board for the period 2021- 2027.

These appointments take place pursuant to art. 9 of the Statute on the basis of candidates presented by the Federations.

Article 11 of the current Statute reads as follows:

"The Confederal Council is the governing body of the Association.

It is made up of a minimum of 9 to a maximum of 15 members who remain in office for a period of 6 years and who cannot be elected for more than two consecutive terms.

The members of the Confederal Council, except two, are elected by the Ordinary Assembly, which will previously establish the number in compliance with the provisions of an Electoral Regulations. A member of the Confederal Council is indicated by the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians as its Confederal Delegate among members of the Institute.

The General Councillor for the Salesian Family of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians takes part in the Council meetings with the right to vote."

It is essential that each Federation that intends to submit a candidacy of one of their associates as a member of the Confederal Council must take into account, in choosing, the following competencies:

- Knowledge of the Association: identity, history, vision, mission, documents, etcetera.
- Knowledge of the Mornesian Salesian Charism (Identity Document, Identity Card of the Salesian Family, Statute)
- At least six years of government in the Association at various levels (with specification in the Curriculum Vitae of the candidate)
- Understanding of at least one foreign language (Italian, French, Spanish, Portuguese, or English)
- Availability dating link now different by time zone
- Computer skills operating systems (Windows, Android, etcetera.), software: Word, PowerPoint, digital platforms
- Use of social media (WhatsApp, Facebook, Twitter, etcetera.)
- Age between minimum 35 and maximum 75 years
- Ability to work in a team

- Motivation to carry out the assignment with commitment and responsibility
- Flexibility to quickly adapt to the context to perform different tasks with the same skill and ability.
- Problem-solving skills
- Persuasive skills to become a thought leader
- Communication skills
- Not to hold the office of President of the Federation or Union or of the Mornese Onlus Association (this situation must be removed within the deadline set by the Electoral Regulations)
- Not to be in a relationship of marriage, kinship, or affinity up to the fourth degree included with the members of the Supervisory Body

The Assembly is also convened for the appointment of the members of the Supervisory Body (single or collective).

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Degree in economics and/or law
- Experience gained in the field of economic and financial management and consultancy regarding non-profit associations
- Knowledge of the Italian language
- The office of a member of the Supervisory Board is incompatible with any other office held in the Association and Federations
