1. We continued to meet with you throughout the year and communicated the different aspects and projects. We had four meetings throughout the year.
2. After almost a year of planning and working, the Confederation finalized Our DREAMS, OUR CHALLENGES, and Our PATHS for working on the next five years. You are the recipients of these endeavors!
3. During the first quarter of the year, the councilors meet with each Federation to understand the culture, dynamics, and state of each Federation. As well as to understand the difficulties and challenges that each Region was dealing with. Throughout the world, we had the same primary concerns: the pandemic, the Replacement of Councils, either at the Federation level or the Unions, the Alignment to New Statutes, the Political State of the Country, and the Provinces Redefined.

  5. We had a tremendous response on the celebration of the 150th anniversary of the Institute, giving Mother and her Council a "Book of Gratitude" They were very pleased and enjoyed it tremendously.
  6. The Certificate project was done, and most Federations have certificates. If you still want your Federation to have them, you still need to follow the procedure to ensure we have the correct names of the Associates. The information on how to proceed is still the same.
  7. In the last quarter of the year, the project of Solidarity was put in place, and for the year 2023, the finalist was the Federation of Myanmar, where the needs of the population in flight are significant. We had eight projects presented.
  8. Last but not least, we are working with the different Regions on their Congresses. Following will be the Africa Congress in September, then in 2024, we will have the Asia-Pacific Congress and the American Congress.
