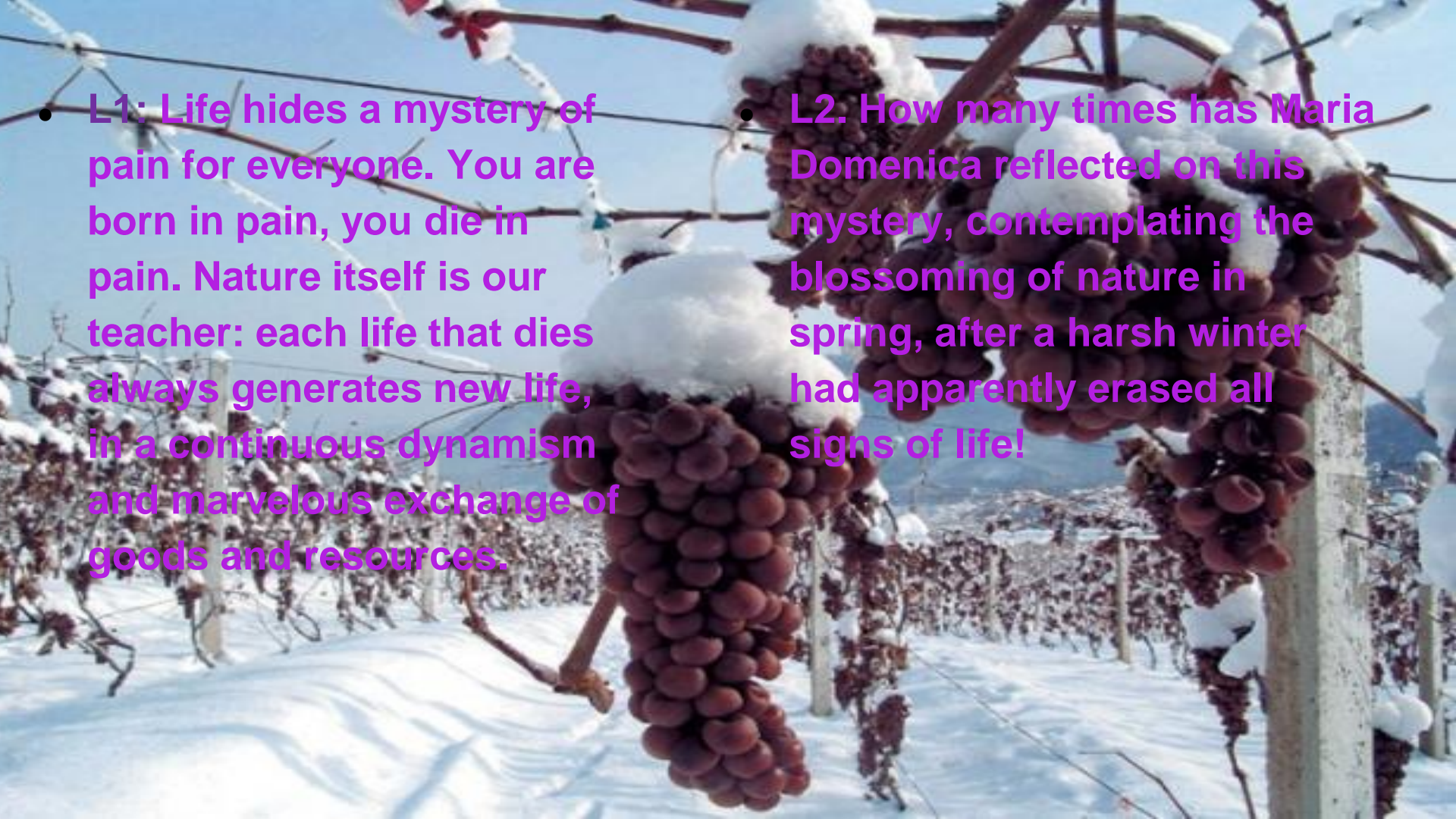


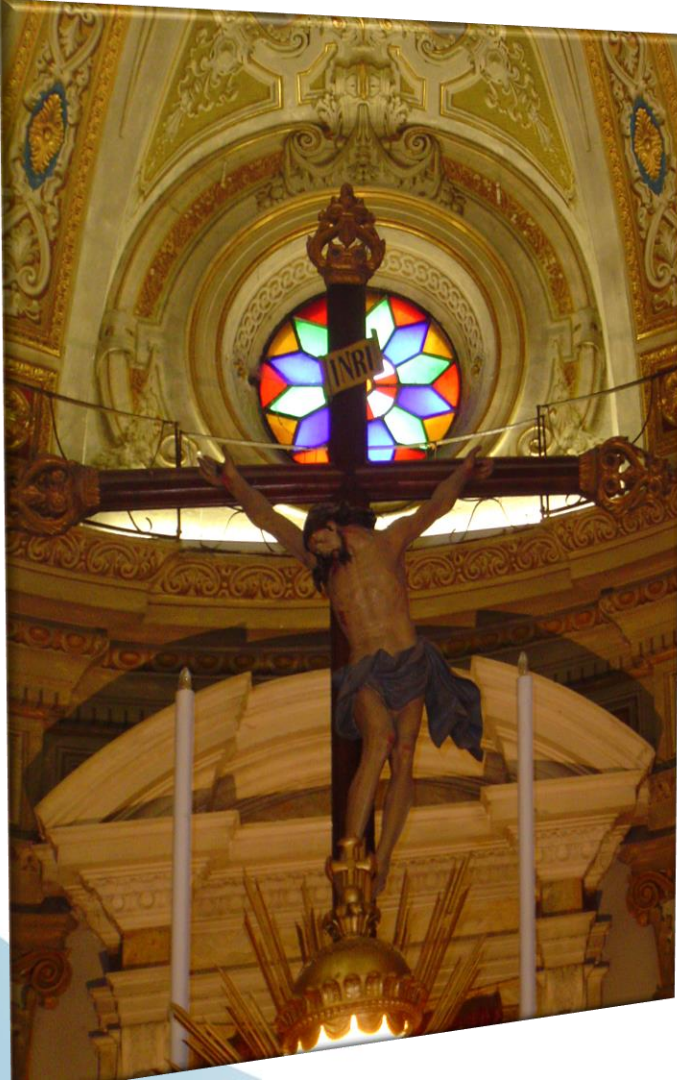
Opening Prayer

You are clean, even now, through the teaching which I have given you.

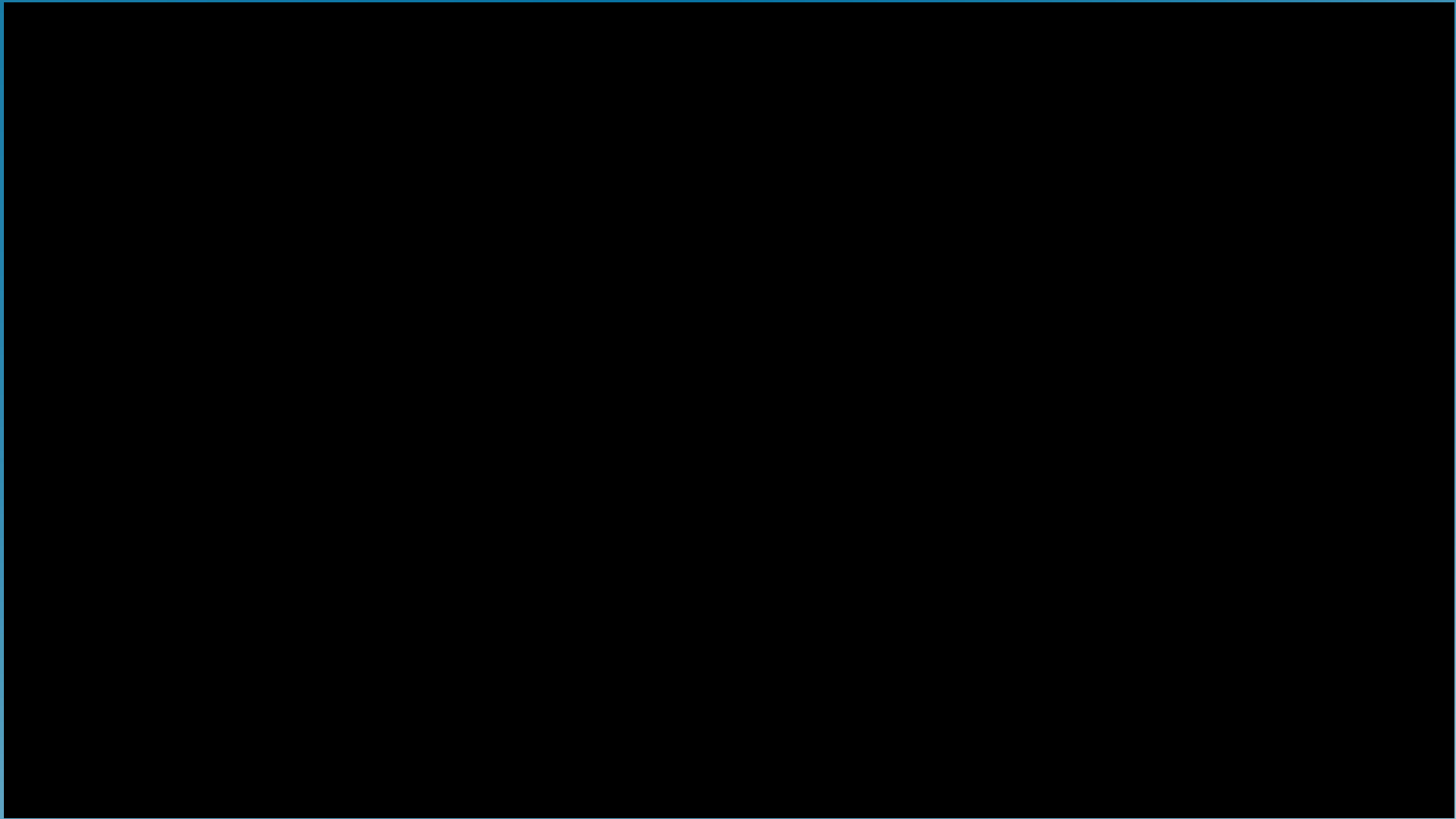
Be in me at all times as I am in you. As the I am the vine, you are the branches: he who is in me at all times as I am in him, gives much fruit, because without me you are able to do nothing
