DATES:

We are pleased to announce the opening of the International Congress on Hope for the Jubilee Year 2025, organized by the World Confederation of Past Pupils of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians.

The event will be held in Sacrofano - Rome, from May 25 to May 29, 2025.

PURPOSE of the Congress:

The theme of the International Congress stems from Pope Francis' invitation on Thursday, May 9, during the delivery of the Bull of Induction for the Ordinary Jubilee 2025:

"LET US NOT ALLOW OUR HOPE TO BE STOLEN" (EG 86).

It will be an opportunity to meet, dialogue, and reflect together, but above all, an invitation to walk towards a better future based on hope, mercy, and fraternity.
